INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. NOTE: The instructions show for a lifted vehicle. For stock ride height, instructions will be the same with the exception of the spacer.
- 2. Jack up the rear of the vehicle and place on jack stands.
- 3. Remove the wheels.
- 4. Remove the ABS wire from the frame using a trim remove tool. **See Photo 1**.
- 5. Remove the bump stop from the frame using a 10mm socket. See Photo 2.






- 6. Install the spacer to the bottom of the bag using supplied 3/8" x 1-1/4" bolts and 9/16" socket/wrench. **See Photo 3**.
- 7. Install lower brackets to the spacer using supplied 3/8" x 3/4" flat head bolts and 7/32" Allen wrench. See Photo 4.





- 8. Install the upper bracket to the top of the bag using supplied 3/8" x 3/4" flat head bolts and 7/32" Allen wrench. Install the 90° fitting. **See Photo 5**.
- 9. Place the air bag assembly on rear axle and secure with the lower straps, 3/8" carriage bolts, and 3/8" flange nuts using a 9/16" socket/wrench. **See Photo 6**.









10. Vehicles without a gooseneck hitch:

Install the upper bracket to the frame using the 3/8 x 4-7/8 x 6-1/4 square u-bolt, and 3/8" flange nuts. See Photo 7.


11. Vehicles with a gooseneck hitch:

Drill a hole for the center hole on the upper bracket using a 21/64" drill bit and install a 3/8" x 1" self tapping bolt instead of the u-bolts using a 9/16" socket/wrench. **See Photo 8**.







- 12. Install the rear of the upper bracket using 3/8" x 1-1/4" bolt and flag nut. See Photo 9.
- 13. Install the inflation valve through the license plate and attach the 1/4" DOT airline to the valves. See Photo 10.





- 14. Secure the brake lines using the clamps on the lower bracket of the air bag. See Photo 11.
- 15. Remove the upper diff bolt and install clamp so secure the brake line brackets. See Photo 12.





16. Put on wheels and lower.

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
