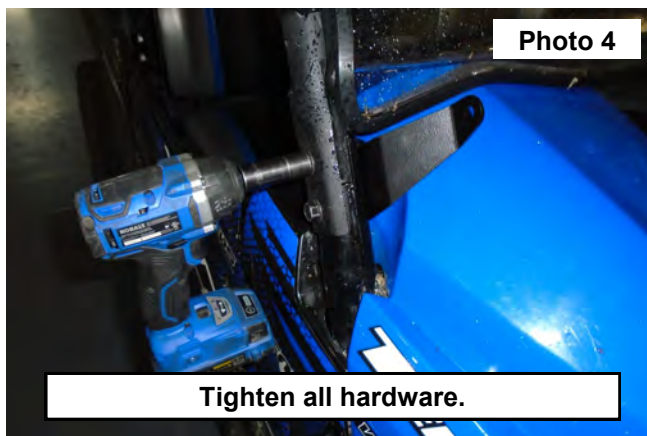
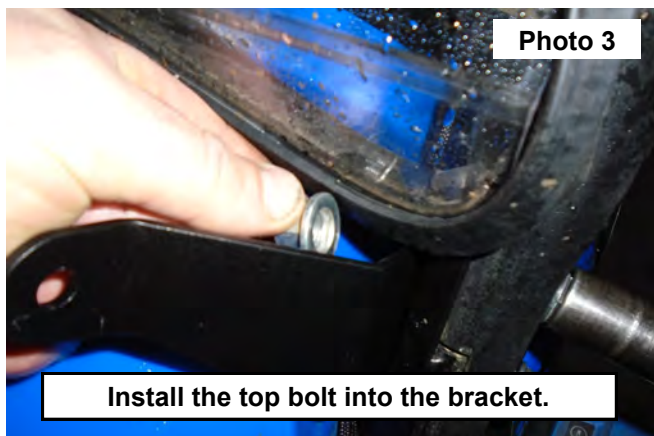


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

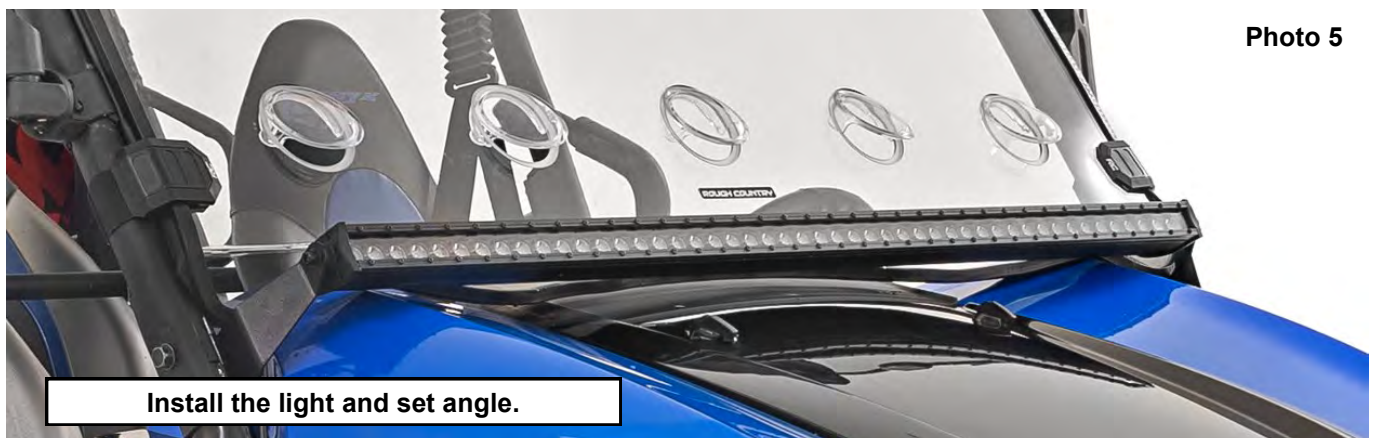
1. Remove the top nut on the roll cage using a 17mm wrench and socket. **See Photo 1.**
2. Loosen the lower nut using a 17mm wrench and socket and slide the bracket into the lower bolt. **NOTE:** The bends of the bracket should be toward the inside of the UTV. **See Photo 2.**



3. Slide the top bolt through the upper hole and secure using the OE nut. **See Photo 3.**
4. Tighten the (2) nuts and bolts using a 17mm wrench and socket. **See Photo 4.**
5. Repeat steps using steps 1-4 for installation on the opposite side.



6. Install the light using the supplied hardware in the light kit. Set the light to the desired angle and tighten. **See Photo 5.**



POST INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Check all fasteners for proper torque. Check to ensure for adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and heated members. Verify clearance between exhaust and brake lines, fuel lines, fuel tank, floorboards, and wiring harness.
2. Check electrical wiring to ensure adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and heated members.
