
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS


- 1. Unbolt the tailgate cable with a T50 Torx. Set cable, washer, and bolt aside. **See Photo 1.**
- 2. Install the tailgate cable bracket by placing it under the factory tailgate washer and bolt. Place tailgate cable back on the factory bolt. Tighten with a T50 Torx. **See Photo 2.**







- 3. Remove the tailgate bolts with a T47 Torx. Retain hardware for reuse.
- 4. Install the supplied bed bracket using the factory bolts using a T47 Torx. See Photo 3.
- 5. Cut supplied hose to about 2" in length with scissors. Now use the scissors to cut the tube down the middle. **See Photo 4.**





- 6. Locate the bottom of the tube approximately 4 1/2" from the tailgate cable. See Photo 5.
- 7. Use electrical tape to secure the hose in place. See Photo 6.







8. Install the tailgate piston with the cylinder going towards the bracket side and the piston going to the tailgate side. **See Photo 7.**



POST INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Check all fasteners for proper torque. Check to ensure for adequate clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and heated members. Verify clearance between exhaust and brake lines, fuel lines, fuel tank, floorboards, and wiring harness.
- 2. All kit components must be retightened at 500 miles and then every 300 miles after installation. Periodically check all hardware for tightness.
