SAFETY WARNING BDS Suspension Co. recommends this system be installed by a professional technician. In addition to these instructions, professional knowledge of disassembly/ reassembly procedures and post installation checks must be known.

PRE-INSTALLATION NOTES

- 1. Special literature required: OE Service Manual for model/year of vehicle. Refer to manual for proper disassembly/reassembly procedures of OE and related components.
- 2. Adhere to recommendations when replacement fasteners, retainers and keepers are called out in the OE manual.
- 3. Secure and properly block vehicle prior to installation of BDS Suspension components. Always wear safety glasses when using power tools.
- 4. To properly perform installation, you must use two (2) large C-clamps or a large vise to contain the elastic potential energy in a leaf spring when the center bolt is removed.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 5. Remove the distributor cap to avoid damage.
- 6. Place a jack under the transfer case crossmember and remove the frame to cross member bolts.
- 7. Carefully lower the transfer case so the crossmember is about 1" below the frame on both sides.
- 8. Install the supplied transfer case spacers between the crossmember and frame. Install the new bolts and nuts supplied and tighten to specification.
- 9. Install the distributor cap.
- 10. Inspect the fasteners for tightness periodically.
